

6.9 million Peruvians live in poverty - nearly one out of two Peruvians - three out of five in the case of children - and one out of five is extremely poor. Some of the main causes contributing to poverty in Peru are natural disasters, the stark divide between rich and poor, and inequality faced by women. A large number of indigenous children under 5 years old suffer from chronic malnutrition.
