## COUNTRY CHALLENGES:

In Zambia, 20 percent of all children were orphans in 2005, over half of them due to AIDS, leaving a population of 11.7 million to support more than 1.2 million orphans. This epidemic puts children at risk physically, emotionally, and economically; and oftentimes threatens their survival. In most affected countries in this region children are missing out on what they need for survival, growth and development, and progress on key national development goals are jeopardized.
